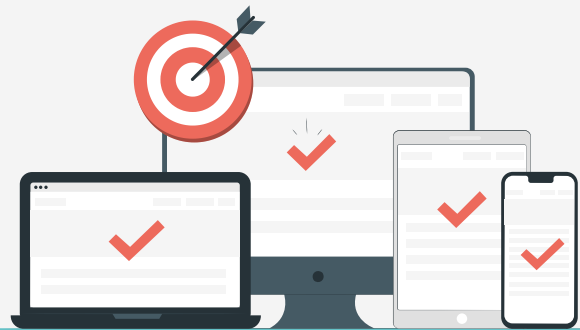

## How do we protect your personal data?

# What are your rights regarding your personal data?



The LGPD grants the following rights to data subjects:



Request confirmation regarding the use of your personal data



Request access to your personal data



Request correction of incomplete, inaccurate, or outdated personal data



Request blocking, deletion, or anonymization of unnecessary, excessive, or improperly processed personal data under the LGPD



Request the portability of your personal data, in accordance with criteria defined in due course by the National Data Protection Authority (ANPD)



Revoke any consent previously provided for the use of your personal data

Request the deletion of personal data processed based on your consent



Request information about the sharing of your personal data



Request information about the consequences of refusing to authorize the use of your personal data



Oppose to the improper use of your personal data
